Teacher Grant Program Guidelines

The Old Farmers Road School PTO is offering a Teacher Grant Program for the school year. The PTO considers the Teacher Grant Program to be an investment designed to support creative and innovative ideas for learning. The program is intended to foster the exploration and development of new educational methods of teaching. These methods should support the curriculum and positively enhance student learning.

The OFRS PTO Grant Program will award a total of \$5,000 (maximum \$500 per grant or recipient). No capital improvements, personal compensation for teachers or textbook purchases will be considered. Awarded funds must be used within the current school year and within normal school hours. Any items purchased as part of the OFRS PTO Grant Program are not owned by the individual who submitted for the Grant and must remain at OFRS.

Requirements and Procedures

- 1. Grant applicant(s) must belong to the OFRS PTO.
- 2. One application may be submitted per teacher, individually or as part of a group
- 3. Please include any applicable attachments to your grant application.
- 4. The Principal will review each application to ensure that it supports the curriculum.
- 5. Approved applications will be given to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will approve or decline proposed grants based on the judging criteria discussed below.
- 6. The Executive Committee will announce approved grants at the next general membership meeting. At that time, grant recipients must present the project for which they have received the grant to the general membership.
- 7. The PTO President will distribute grant approval letters detailing the amount approved. Funds will be reimbursed by the PTO Treasurer for approved grants.

Judging criteria

1. Creativity	30%
2. Interdisciplinary application	20%
3. Ability to replicate activity with minimal budget impact	20%
4. Benefit to students	30%

Important Dates

Grant applications will be welcomed throughout the school year and reviewed as they are submitted. However the deadline will be February 1st in order to allow time for the Grant to be utilized for the school year.

Grant applications must either be submitted to president@ofrspto.org or put into the President's folder in the PTO mailbox.
